This document prescribes how a student may transfer from **Johnston Community College (JCC)** to the University of Mount Olive (UMO) in order to complete a four-year degree in **Bachelor of Science/Business Administration: Accounting**.

UMO's requirements are divided into three areas:

- (1) 43 hours of General Education Requirements (GER), as outlined on page 1;
- (2) 26 hours of General Electives, which are selected by each individual student;
- (3) and 57 hours of business curriculum, as outlined in the pages that follow.
- (4) The total hours required to graduate is 126.

Based on our Accounting Degree Sheet with a key date of 08-16 compared to JCC A25100 Accounting Degree Sheet, the following is submitted yet must be reviewed on a case by case basis.

56sh eligible for transfer:

- 15sh in GERs
 - Since a typical student may have a variety of courses to choose from in some areas, the courses from JCC's plans are listed on page 1
- 26sh in General Electives
 - Must be 100-200 level with a grade of C or higher
 - When courses have same name as our upper level course, we usually stay away from bringing those in as electives
- 15sh in business core and major

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Complete 43 hours as outlined below, 43 hours to prepare you for your Accounting major, plus an additional 26 general elective hours of your choosing (69 hours maximum). This satisfies the General Education Requirements (GER) for the University of Mount Olive. Once you arrive at the University of Mount Olive, it is recommended that you follow the suggested class schedule according to your degree program, as outlined on the pages that follow. *NOTE: 64 sh transfer limit in GERs, Electives, Business Core, and Business Major courses. For Business Core and Business Major courses, must have a grade of C or better.*
