This document prescribes how a student may transfer from Vance-Granville Community College to the University of Mount Olive (UMO) in order to complete a four-year degree in early childhood education. The total hours required in order to transfer from Vance-Granville Community College to UMO and graduate with a degree is 126.

The requirements are divided into areas: 34 hours of **General Education Requirements (GER)**, as outlined on page 1; 31 hours of **electives**, which are selected by each individual student; and 62 hours of **ECE curriculum** (19 hours of which could be transferred), as outlined in the pages that follow.

Community college students could thus transfer a total of 64 hours. These credits could comprise a combination of hours from the GER, electives, and ECE courses (which are allowed for transfer as seen below). Once students arrive at the University of Mount Olive, it is recommended that they follow the suggested class schedule according to their degree program

42 hours of coursework in the ECE major

20 hours of coursework for GER/elective credit
