This document updates the agreement signed in April of 2017 by the Presidents of both institutions. The matrix of transfer equivalencies was updated to re-categorize several courses as follows:

HEA 110 transfers as a Citizenship GER (not Global Understanding)
HUM 115 transfers as a Global Understanding GER (not Citizenship)
BIO 110/111 transfers for UMO BIO 120
BIO 168 transfers for UMO BIO 251

CHM 090 has been deleted—by UMO policy a 090 course would not transfer

Agreement:

This document prescribes how a student may transfer from Wake Technical Community College to the University of Mount Olive (UMO) in order to complete a four-year degree in Recreation and Leisure Studies. The total number of hours required for transfer from Wake Technical Community College to UMO and graduate with the degree is 126.

The requirements for graduation from UMO are divided into the following areas: 46 hours of **General Education Requirements (GER)**, as outlined herein; 12 hours of **electives**, which are selected by each individual student; and 68 hours of Recreation and Leisure Studies and Health and Fitness Science studies as outlined in the pages that follow.

Students entering this program as graduates of the AAS Health and Fitness Science, Wake Technical Community College will be able to transfer up to a total of 64 hours. These credits are comprised of a combination of hours from the GER, electives, and ECE courses (which are allowed for transfer as seen below). Once students arrive at the University of Mount Olive, it is recommended that they follow the suggested class schedule according to their degree program.

Agreement notes:

- To benefit under this agreement, the student must be a graduate of the AAS in Health and Fitness Science from Wake Technical Community College.
- Courses identified in this agreement will transfer (subject to limits) if/when the student has earned a grade of "C" or better in the course.
- Students accepted to UMO under the terms of this agreement will transfer to UMO with Junior status.
- The parties agree to review the agreement on an annual basis and to immediately report changes to the program of study. Said changes will trigger an immediate reevaluation of the terms of the agreement.
- UMO agrees to provide WTCC with an annual report on the progress of the agreement including the number of students admitted to the program under the agreement and graduation status. Additionally, UMO agrees to provide WTCC with an admissions contact dedicated to advising potential students under this agreement and, if appropriate, a UMO webpage dedicated to information on transfer opportunities.
- Wake Tech agrees to provide UMO with access to student transfer events, contact information for the department and student services personnel for agreement administration.

GENERAL EDUCATION REQUIREMENTS: The courses in this table help satisfy the General Education Requirements (GER) for the University of Mount Olive. Courses completed here and in subsequent sections enable a student to transfer in with junior status. Once a student arrives at the University of Mount Olive, it is recommended that they follow the suggested class schedule according to the degree program, as outlined on the pages that follow. Classes completed at Wake Tech Community College as outlined in the far right column, will constitute 25 credit hours into the UMO GER.
